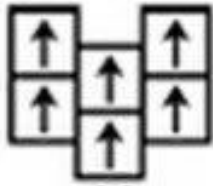
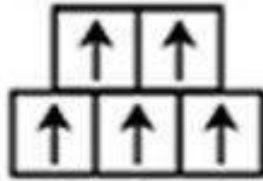


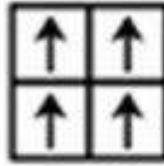
Inspiration Commercial Carpet Tile Installation patterns



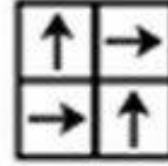

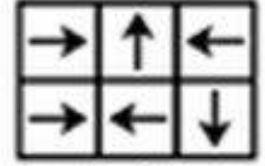

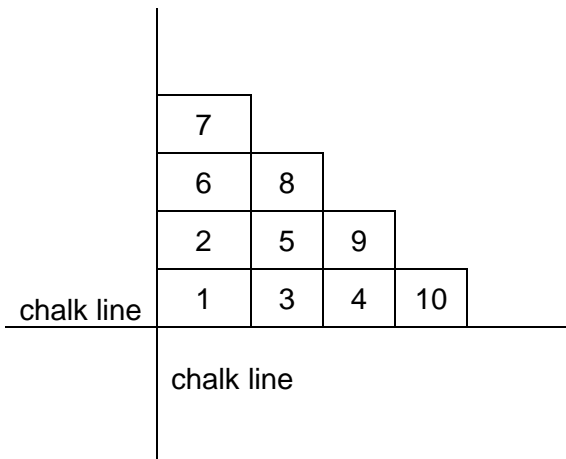

TOOLS NEEDED: tape measure • chalk line • large straightedge • carpet knife

These installation guidelines are intended to assist the installer. Any variance from these guidelines will become the responsibility of the person who is doing the installation and not the manufacturer. **WARNING:** Never sand or scrape asbestos tile. Removal of any products containing asbestos must be done by licensed trained professionals.

LAYOUT FOR YOUR CARPET TILE

Start the installation as near the center of the room as possible by snapping a chalk line from one wall to the opposite wall. Do this in width and length.



INSTALLING YOUR TILE

Each tile has directional arrows on the back. These styles allow for turning the tiles one direction or multiple directions, resulting in many design possibilities. You can even mix patterns of the same construction for something unique.

It is a good idea to lay out 8 or 10 tiles the way you want them to make sure you have the flooring design you prefer before adhering them to the floor.
