## **G-Floor Garage Flooring Installation**

#### **Quick Start Guide**

- 1. Sweep and clean the floor thoroughly
- 2. Unroll mat starting from the entrance
- 3. Let mat relax for up to 72 hours in cooler temps
- 4. Optional: trim edges for custom fit
- 5. Secure with double-sided tape, seaming tape, or adhesive if needed

#### **Installation Types**

- Floating Mat: No adhesive needed. Leave a 1-inch gap from walls/heavy items
- Adhered Installation: Use acrylic or pressure-sensitive adhesive for full-floor coverage
- Outdoor installation requires full adhesion to substrate.

#### **Common Accessories**

- Seam Tape: Joins mats underneath while allowing movement
- Center Trim: Covers seams and prevents tripping
- Edge Trim: Finishes edges with a tapered look
- Threshold Trim: Prevents dirt, bugs, and moisture from entering

### **Tips**

- Leave a 1" gap from walls or poles
- Use adhesive if heavy items will sit on the mat
- Use tape only on the leading edge—not the entire perimeter
- Trim around drains or obstacles as needed
